Swimming lessons will be provided by the school at the Little Dolphins Swimming Academy, Bound Brook NJ. The children will be transported to the pool twice a week for the first 7 weeks. (Swimming lessons, included in the tuition)

Tuition: A non-refundable deposit of \$50 for each week must be submitted along with your child's application. This deposit will be credited toward the cost of a half or full day program. The balance tuition is due on or before June 15, 2020.

<u>Refund Policy</u>: Withdrawal for any reason, or program changes, prior to June 15, 2020, will result in a full refund less the non-refundable deposit. All withdrawals and program changes must be made in writing and received prior to June 15, 2020. No refund will be given after this date for withdrawal or program changes.
